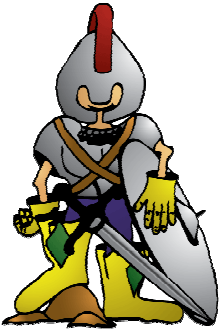

Jr. High

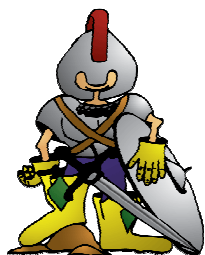
