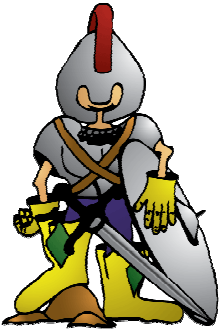

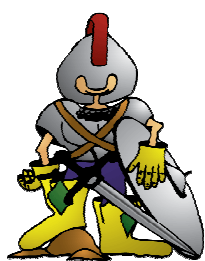
## Jr. High
