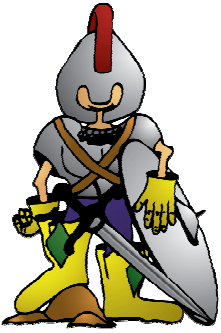


# Valley Christian Academy Good News
