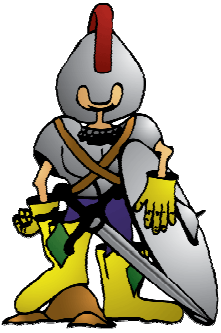

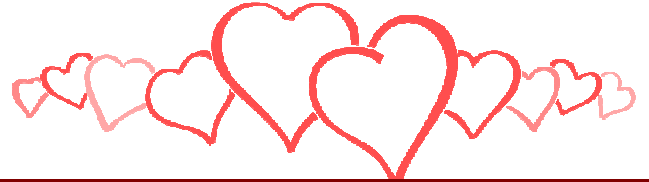
We are so excited to learn about Community Helpers this month. ☺ Pre-K will have a nurse visit our class next week.
