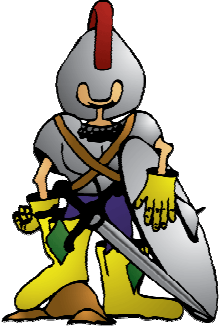

Book Reports are due tomorrow, January 23rd.



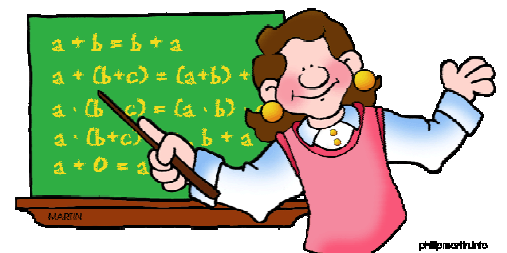
History essays were completed in class today for a test grade.
