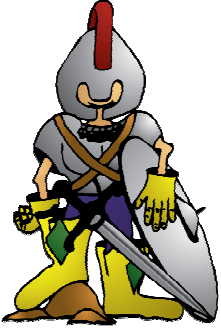


Valley Christian Academy Good News

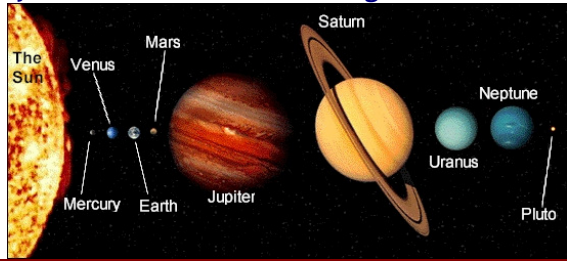
