***Fun Fridays on May 29.** We thank you for your continued support to PTF! Come by and get a sweet treat.

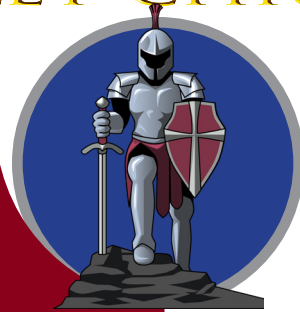
***SURPRISE FUN FRIDAY: June 5 after school!** We will be serving hot dogs, nachos and ice cream. We will have hot dog combos too!
