***SURPRISE FUN FRIDAY:**

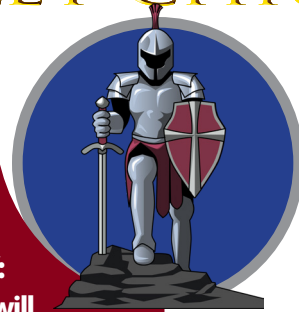
June 5 after school! We will be serving hot dogs, nachos and ice cream. We will have hot dog combos too!
