Hello VCA Families:

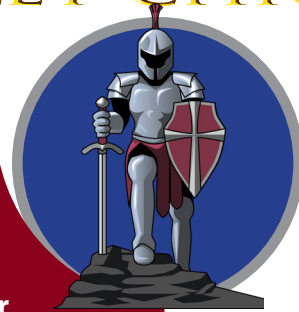
